Professional Training for Christian Ministry

Payne Theological Seminary's academic program leading to the Master of Divinity degree is designed to prepare men and women for competent and faithful service to the Church and to the community in a way that meets the needs of a rapidly changing world.

The Master of Divinity degree is a 90-credit-hour program that can be completed in three to five years of full-time or part-time residential and online study. In addition to the core curriculum, students are guided through a one-year supervised experiential learning experience in a church setting and a non-church setting.

The Master of Divinity degree provides professional training for Christian ministry and further graduate studies. While most Payne students go into the pastoral ministry, the seminary trains persons for work as chaplains, educators, pastoral counselors, community development practitioners, and scholars.

Core curriculum areas of study include:

1. Biblical Studies
2. Historical Studies
3. Theological Studies
4. Practical Ministry
